Tornadoes



Do you know where Tornado Alley is? Did you ever watch *The Wizard of Oz*? If so, do you remember where Dorothy and her dog, Toto, were from?

Although no state is entirely free of tornadoes, they are most frequent in the Plains area between the Rocky Mountains and Appalachians. This area is called Tornado Alley. Oklahoma, Kansas (where Dorothy and Toto were from), Arkansas, Iowa, and Missouri are entirely within Tornado Alley. Parts of other states are

included in this area. The reason there is so many tornadoes in this area is the collision of cold fronts from Canada and warm fronts from the Gulf of Mexico. Tornadoes come in many sizes, but are usually in the form of a funnel cloud, with the narrow end touching the earth.

What do people do when the tornado sirens go off? Many people have basements. They go down in their basement, listen to their radio and wait for the sirens to stop. When I was growing up in Kansas, our house was the only one on the block with a basement. When our neighbors heard the tornado sirens, they would come over with their cats, dogs, birds, and other pets to share the safety of our basement.

Tornadoes can be classified as: weak tornadoes, strong tornadoes, and violent tornadoes. Most tornadoes are weak ones, causing very few deaths, and may only last from one to ten minutes with winds of less than 110 miles per hour. Less than a third of all tornadoes are strong tornadoes, causing less than a third of all tornado deaths. These strong tornadoes can last twenty minutes or longer with winds from 110 to 205 miles per hour. There are very few violent tornadoes, which cause most of the tornado deaths. These tornadoes can last for over an hour and can have winds of over 250 miles per hour.

Warning signs for tornadoes are a dark, often greenish sky, large hail as big as grapefruits; and, if you hear a loud roar similar to a freight train, then run to the nearest shelter!

As with all natural disasters, the best defense is to be well informed and prepared.


